



Admissions

An accredited Bachelor of Arts (BA) or Bachelor of Science (BS) degree is required for entry into the programs of study at Grace Communion Seminary.

Some individuals with an Associate of Arts degree and fifteen years of pastoral experience may petition for entry. Demonstration of Experiential Learning will have to be documented to establish qualifications for doing graduate level work.

Experiential Course I/II:

The experiential elective course is applicable only for the Advanced Diploma in Christian Ministry and the Masters of Pastoral Studies.

Credit can be granted for six units (two courses) for experiential ministry learning, including correspondence courses, pastoral training seminars, or educational seminars in biblical studies, theology, or ministry studies. Seminars must be at least three days in length to qualify.

To receive credit, fill out the transfer form, and send it with the \$25 fee to the Registrar, along with the required documentation.

Documentation must include a six to eight page (single-spaced, with one inch margins, Times New Roman or Ariel 12 point font) summary of the course you completed or the seminar you attended. These can include carefully edited notes from the lectures. At least two pages of the document must be your analysis of application of the course or seminar to the experience of ministry. Relate how it informs or benefits your ministry. This paper will be placed in your educational file.
